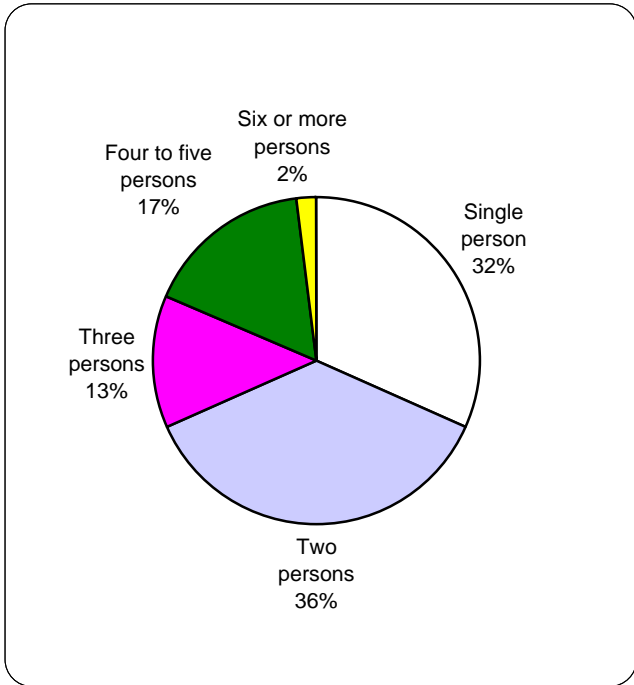

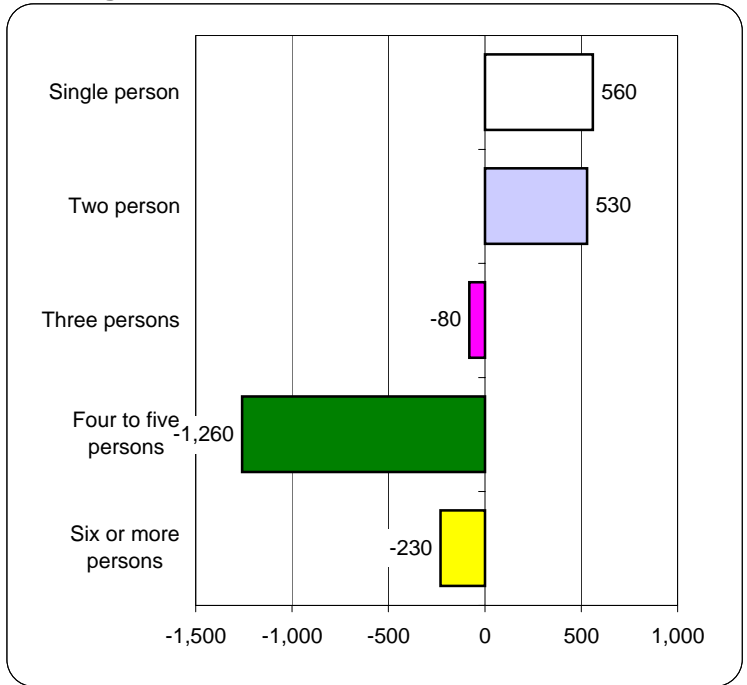

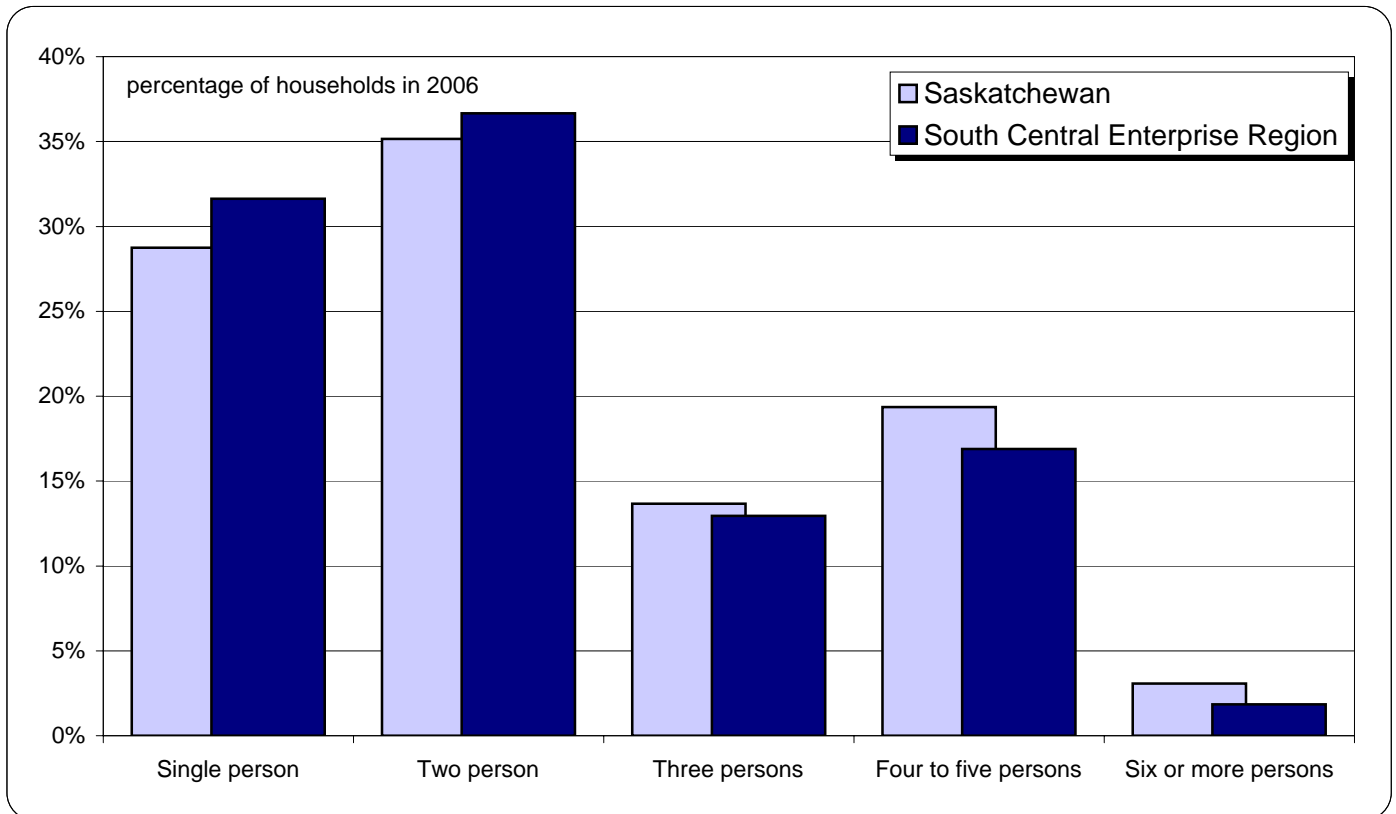
Persons Per Household, 2006



Change in Number of Households, 1996 to 2006

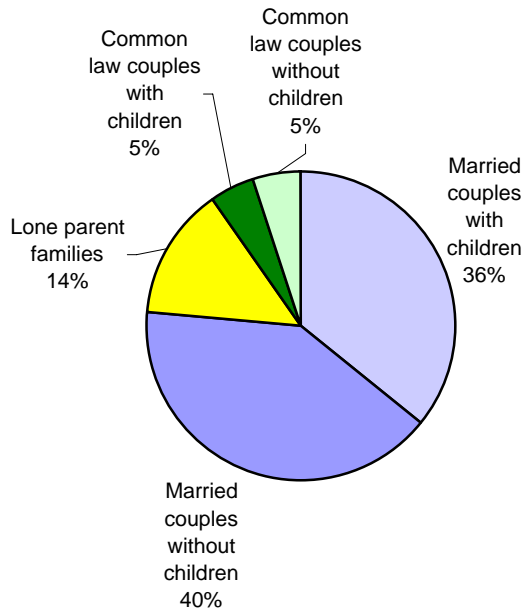


Distributions of Household Size, 2006

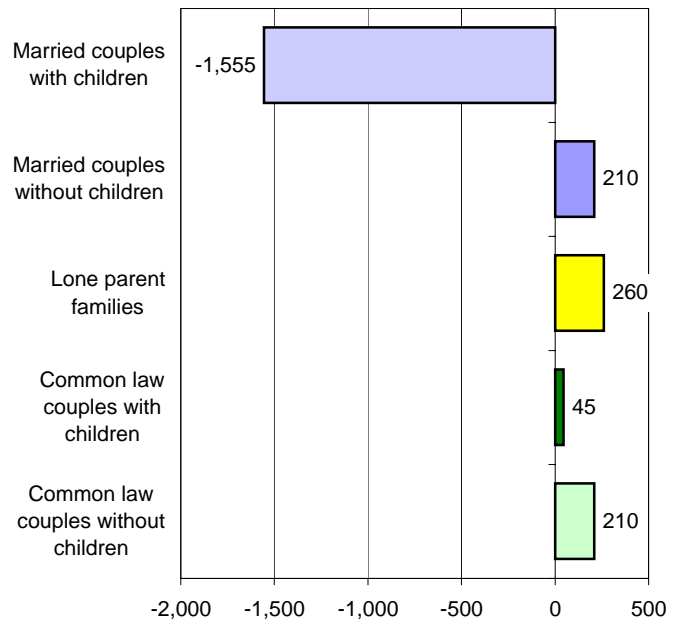


Family Types: South Central Enterprise Region

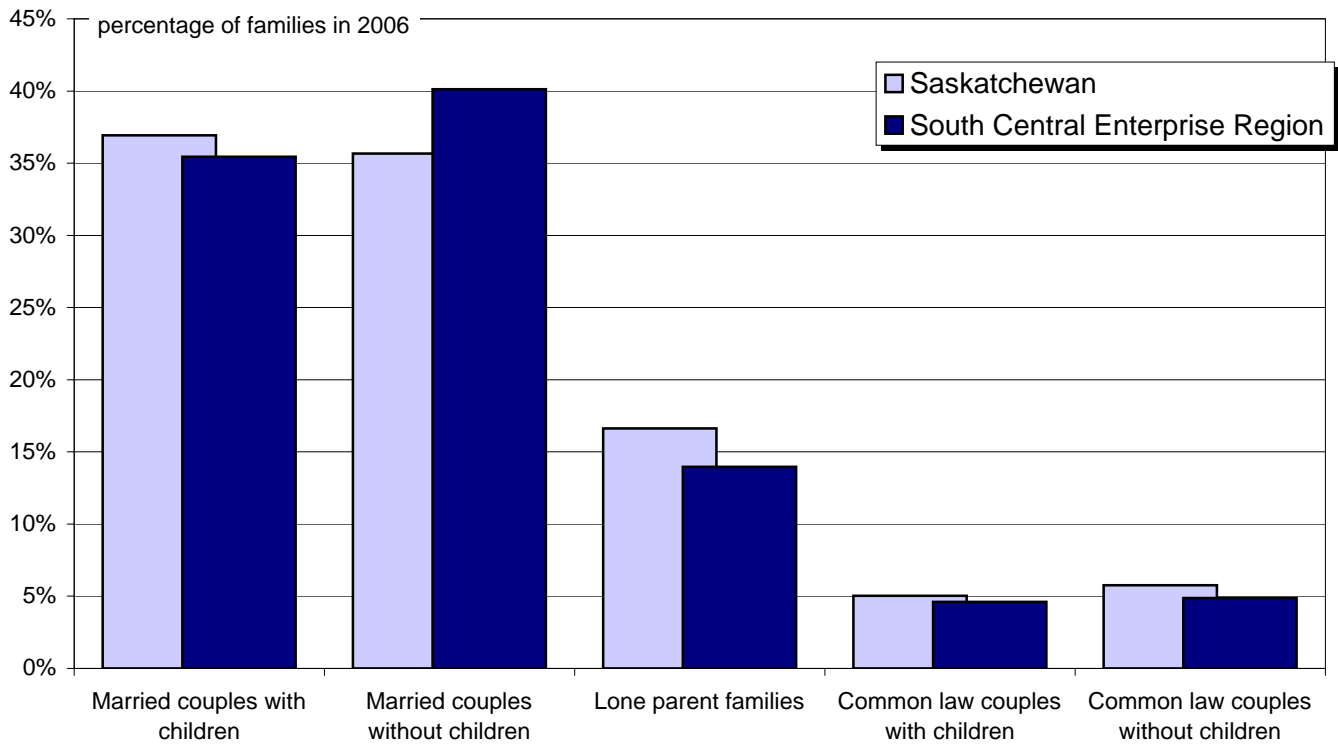
Family Types in 2006



Change in Number of Families, 1996 to 2006

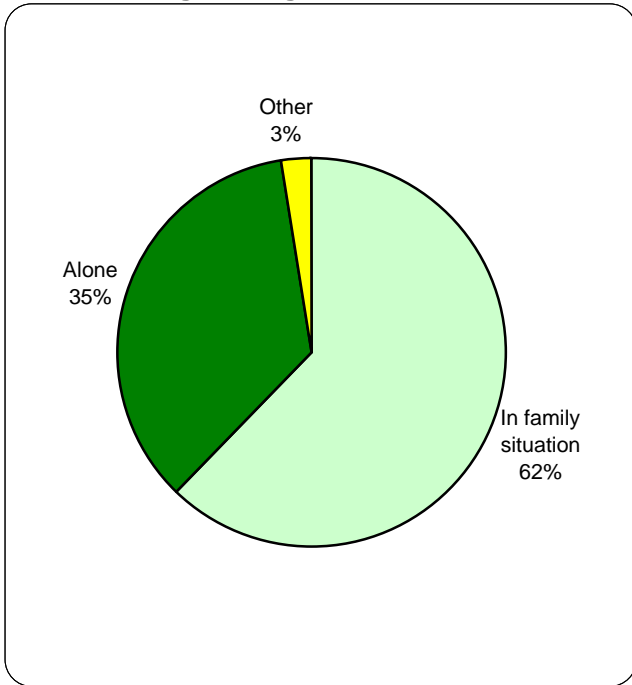


Distributions of Family Types in 2006

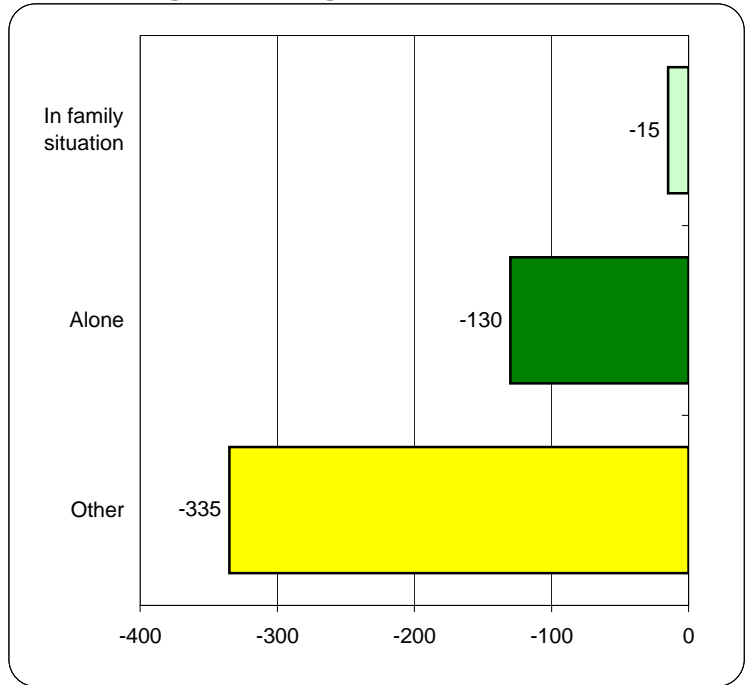


Living Arrangements for Seniors (ages 65 & older): South Central Enterprise Region

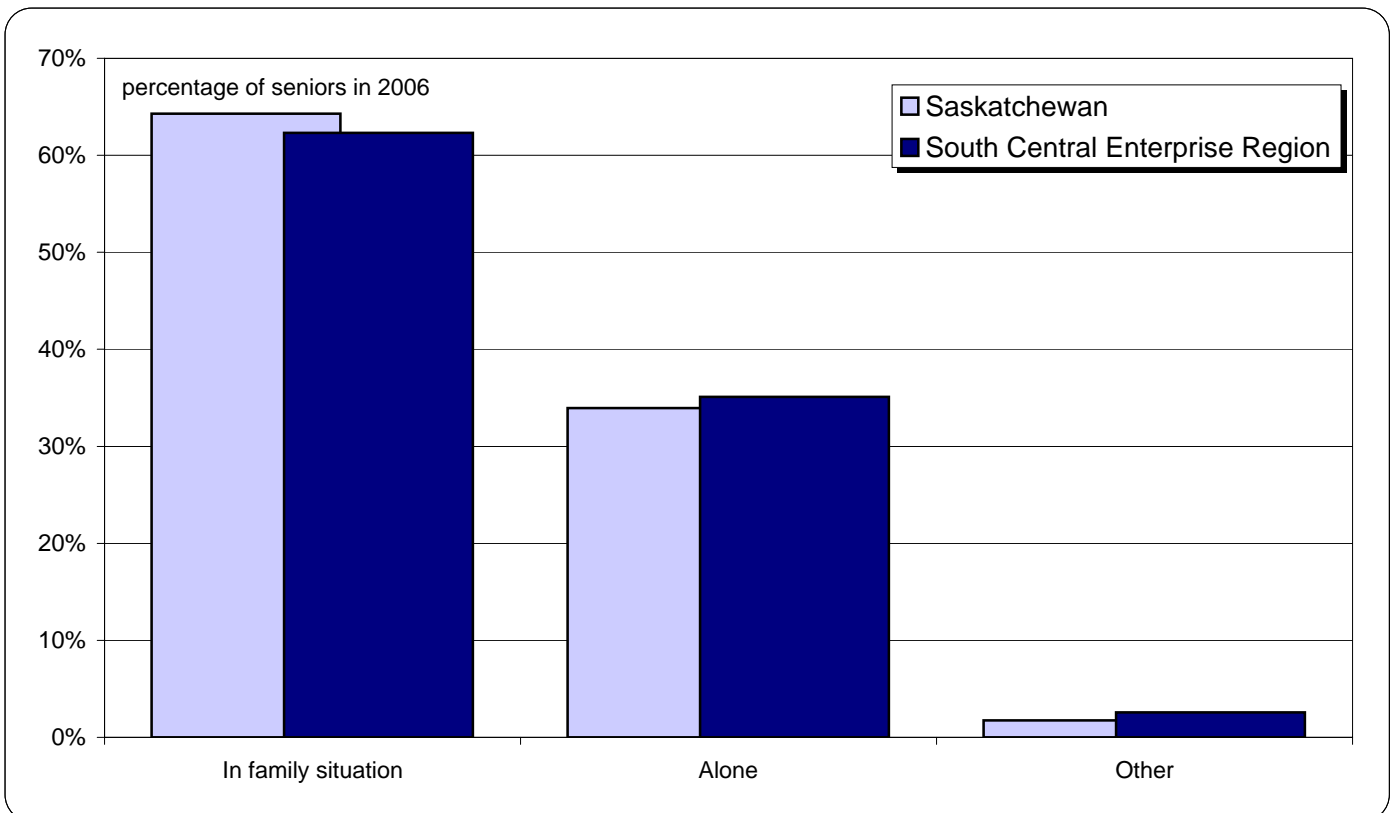
Living Arrangements in 2006



Change in Arrangements, 1996 to 2006

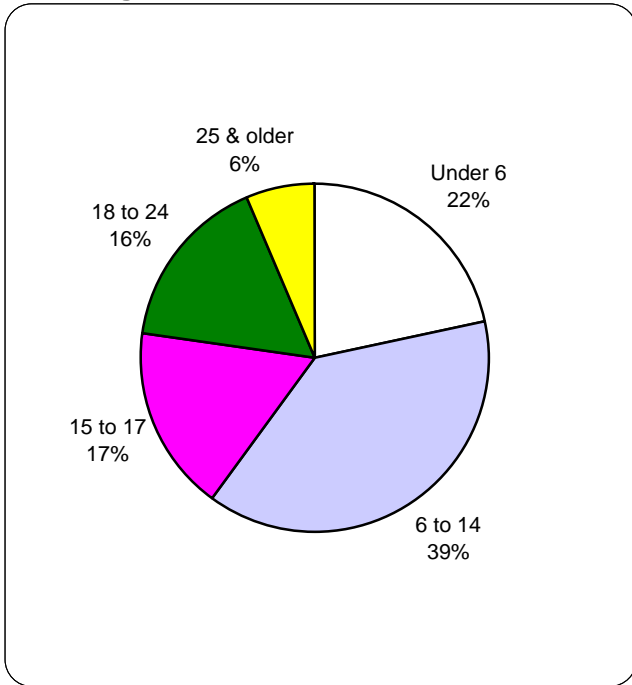

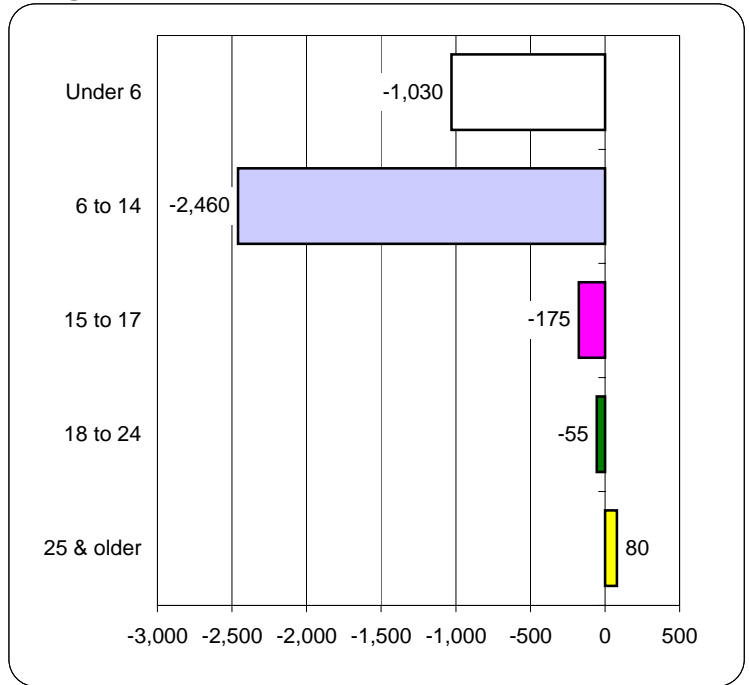


Age of Children Living at Home: South Central Enterprise Region

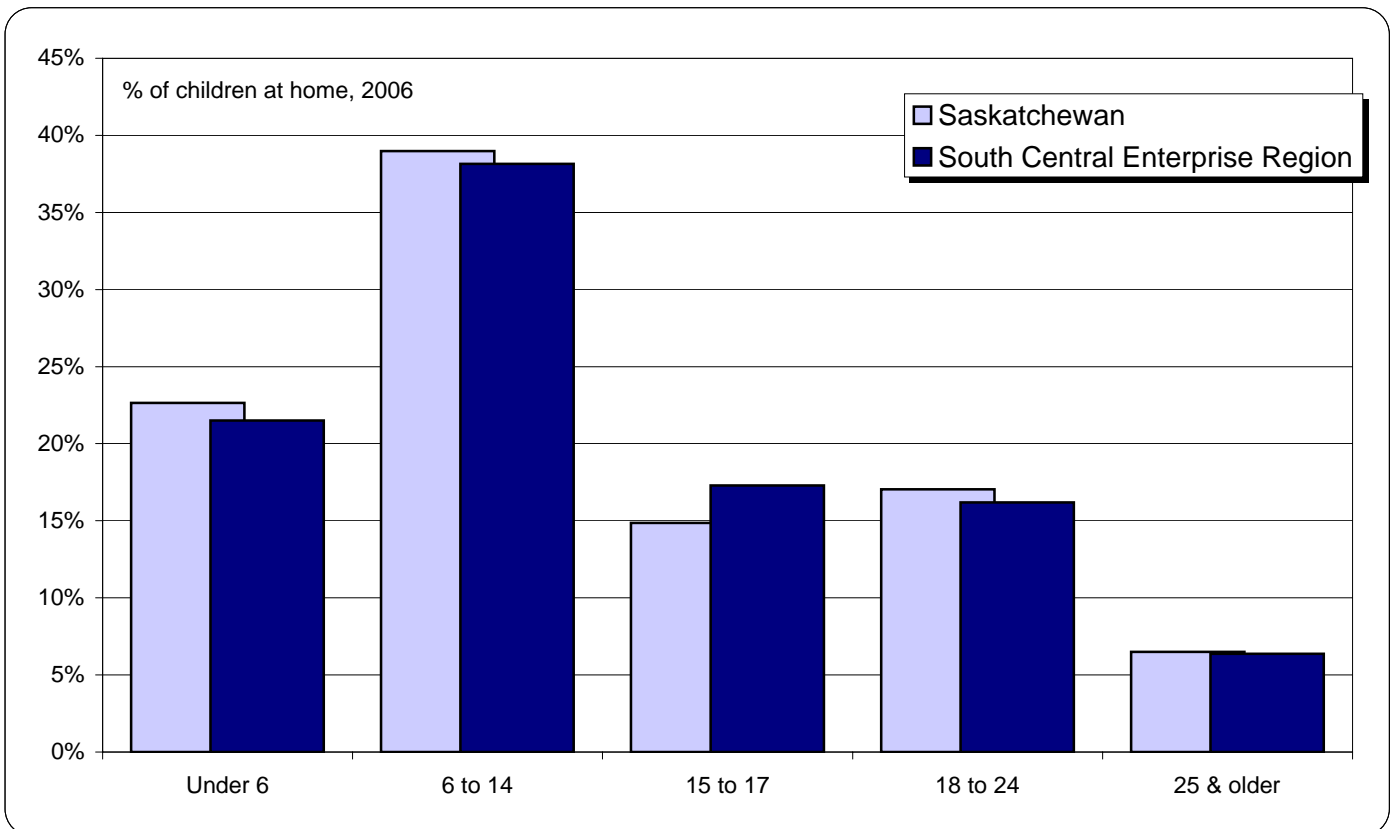
Age of Children at Home, 2006



Change in Number of Children at Home, 1996 to 2006

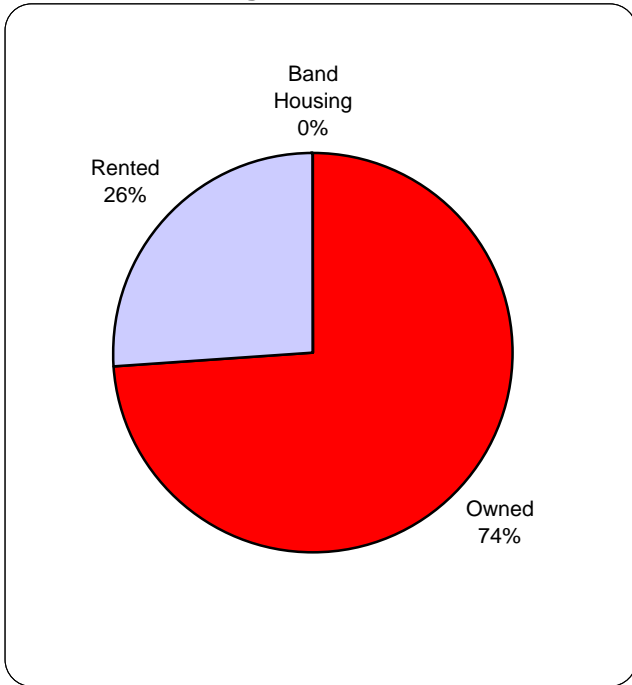


Age of Children Living at Home, 2006

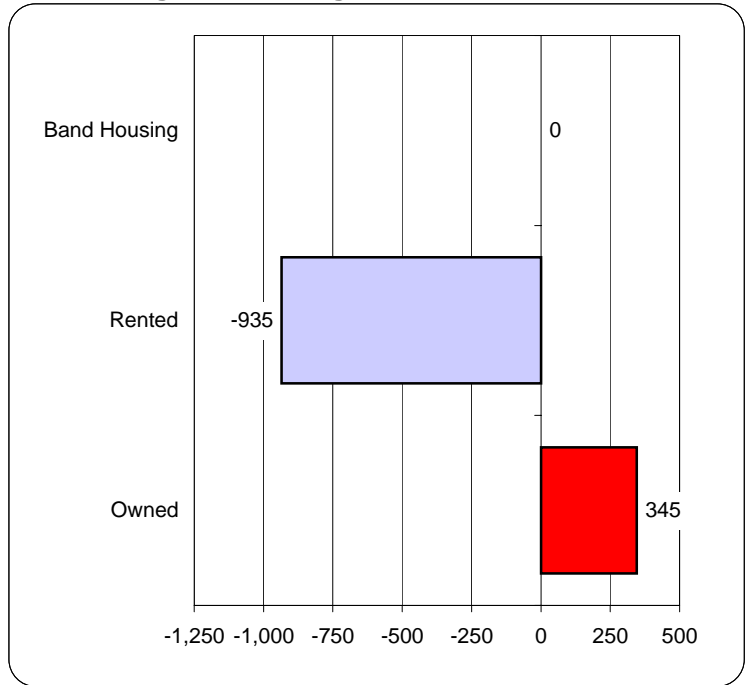


Housing Tenure: South Central Enterprise Region

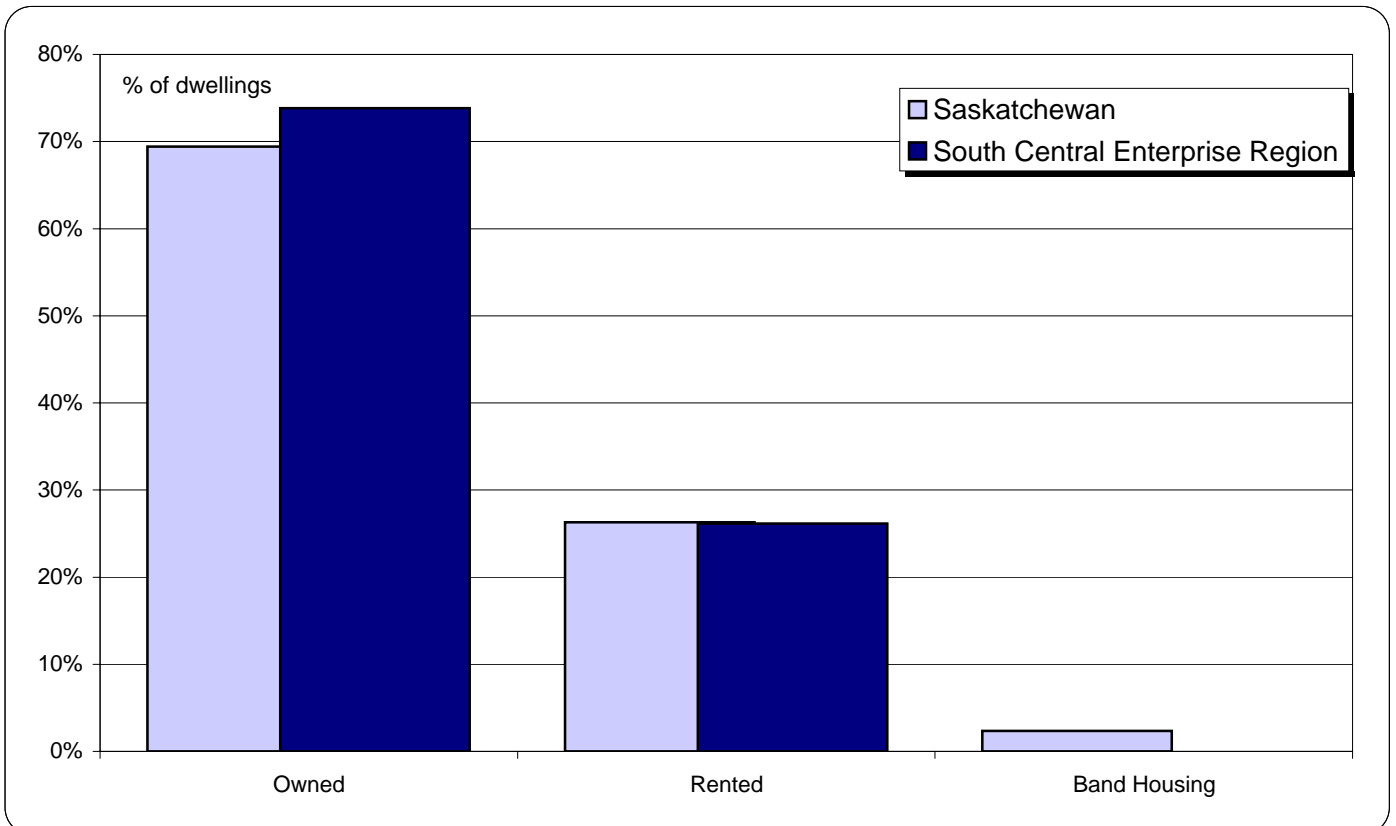
Housing Tenure in 2006



Change in Housing Tenure, 1996 to 2006

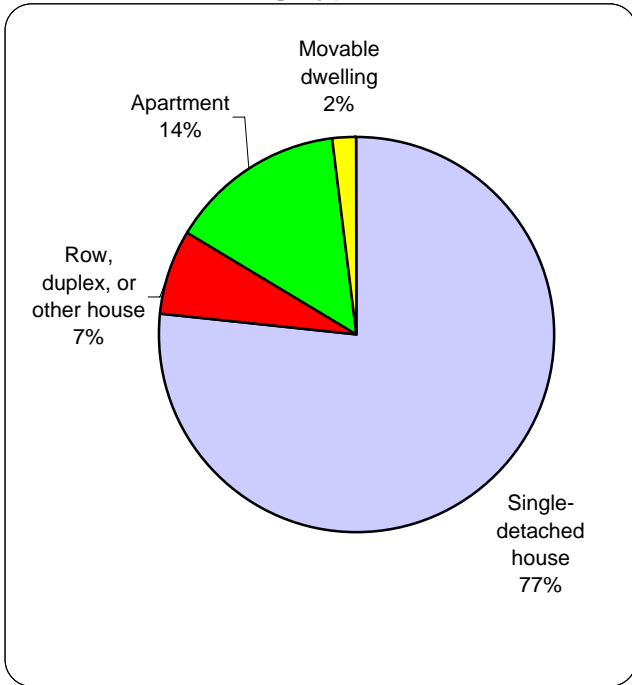


Household Tenure in 2006

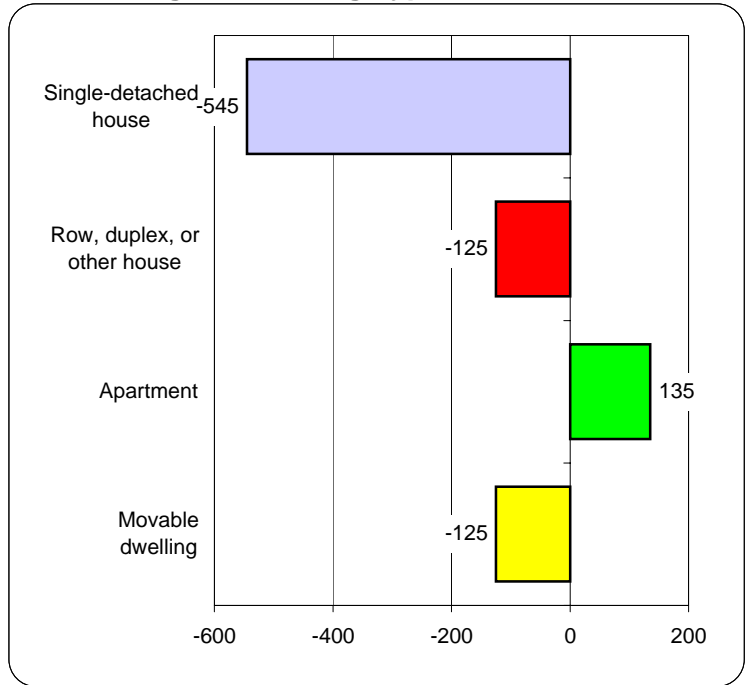


Type of Dwelling: South Central Enterprise Region

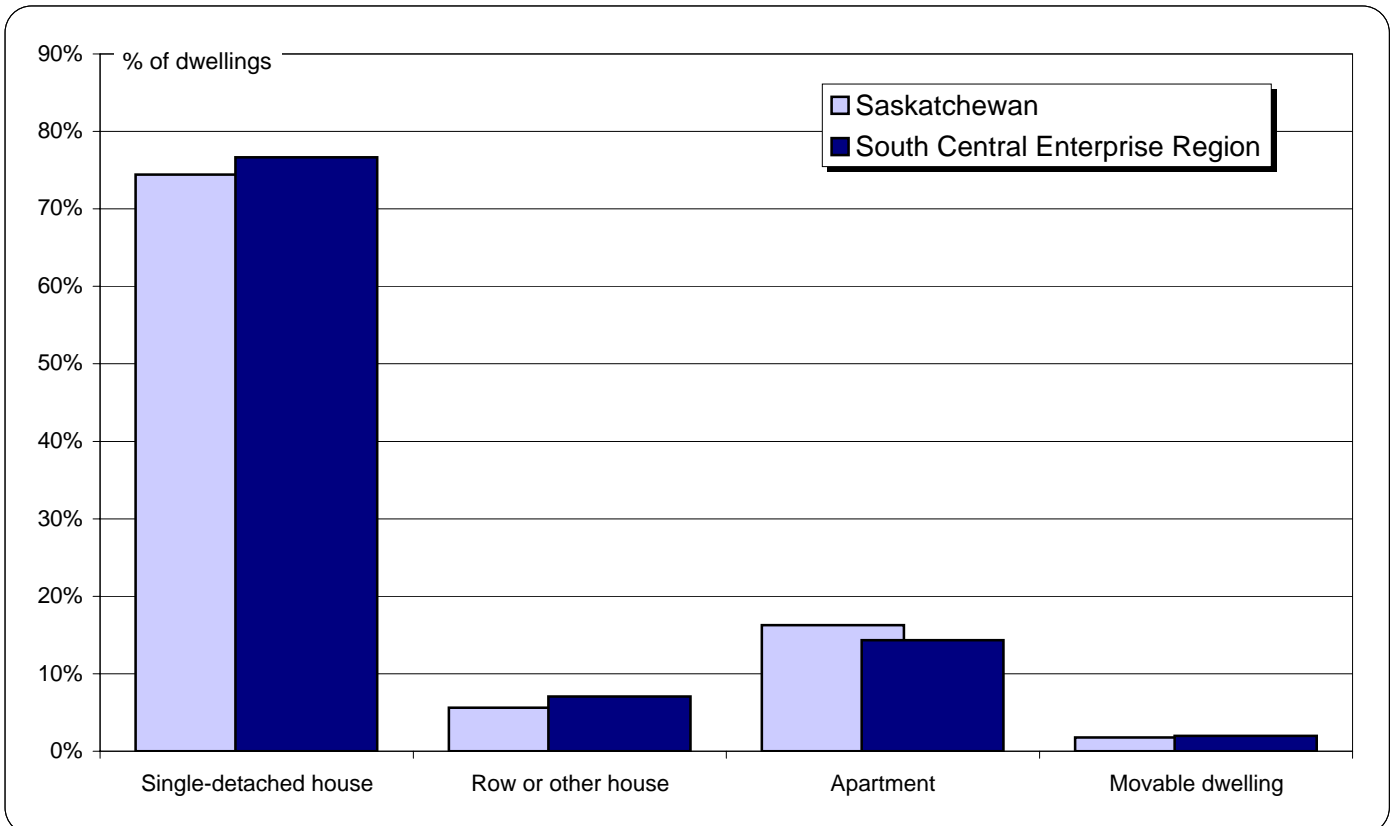
Dwelling Type, 2006



Change in Dwelling Type, 1996 to 2006

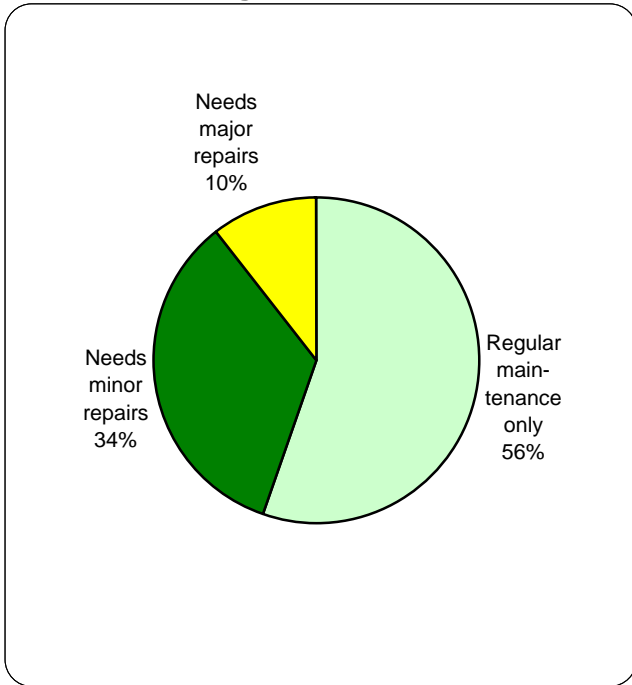


Dwelling Type in 2006

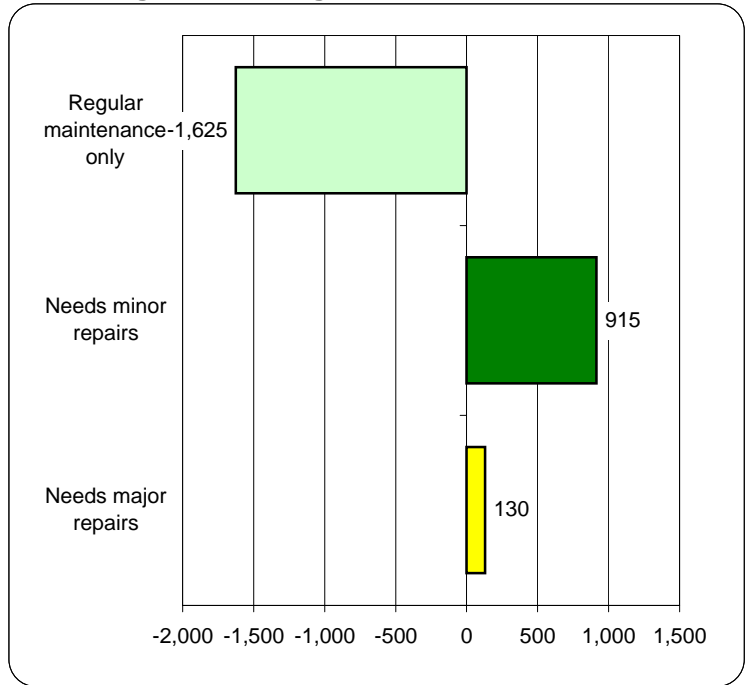


Housing Condition: South Central Enterprise Region

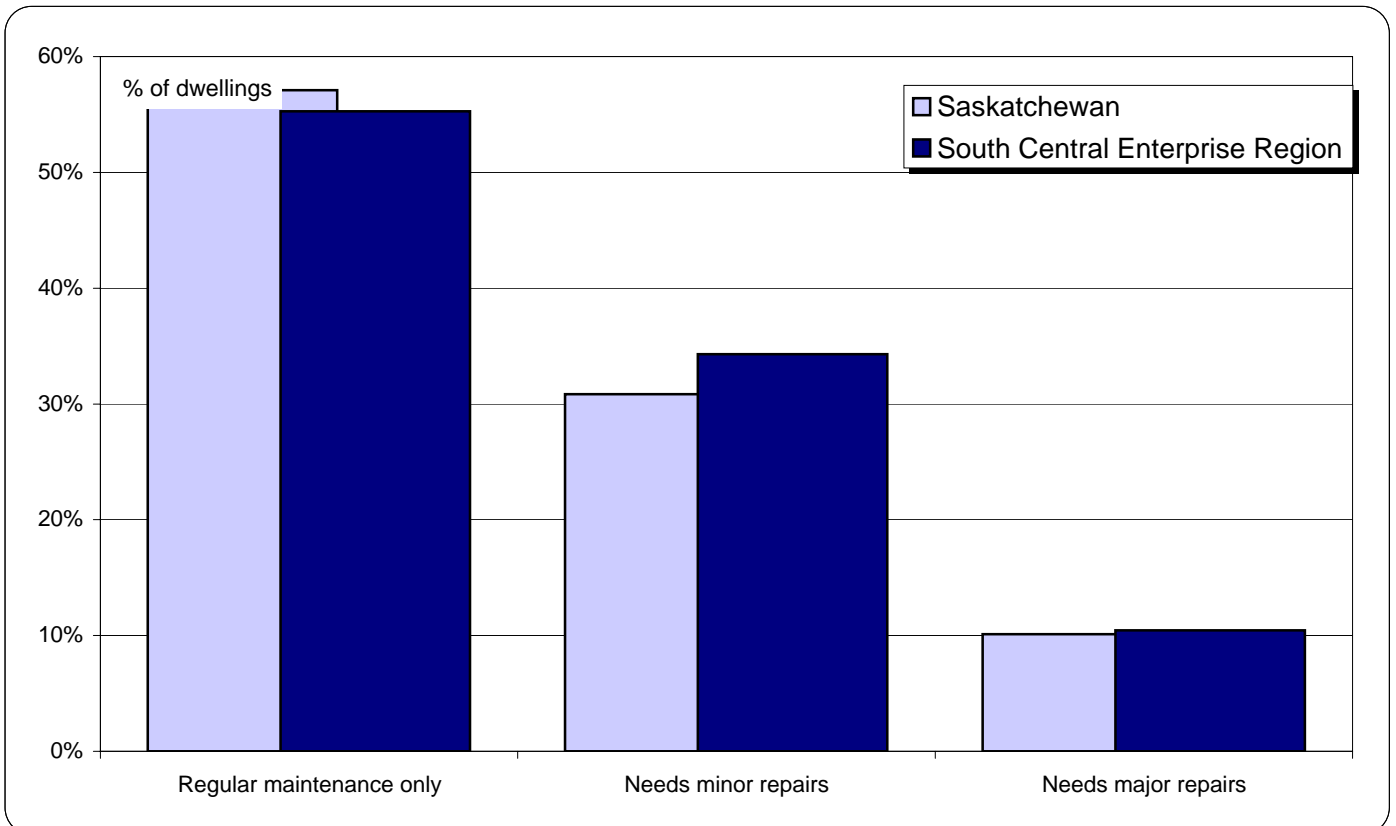
Housing Condition, 2006



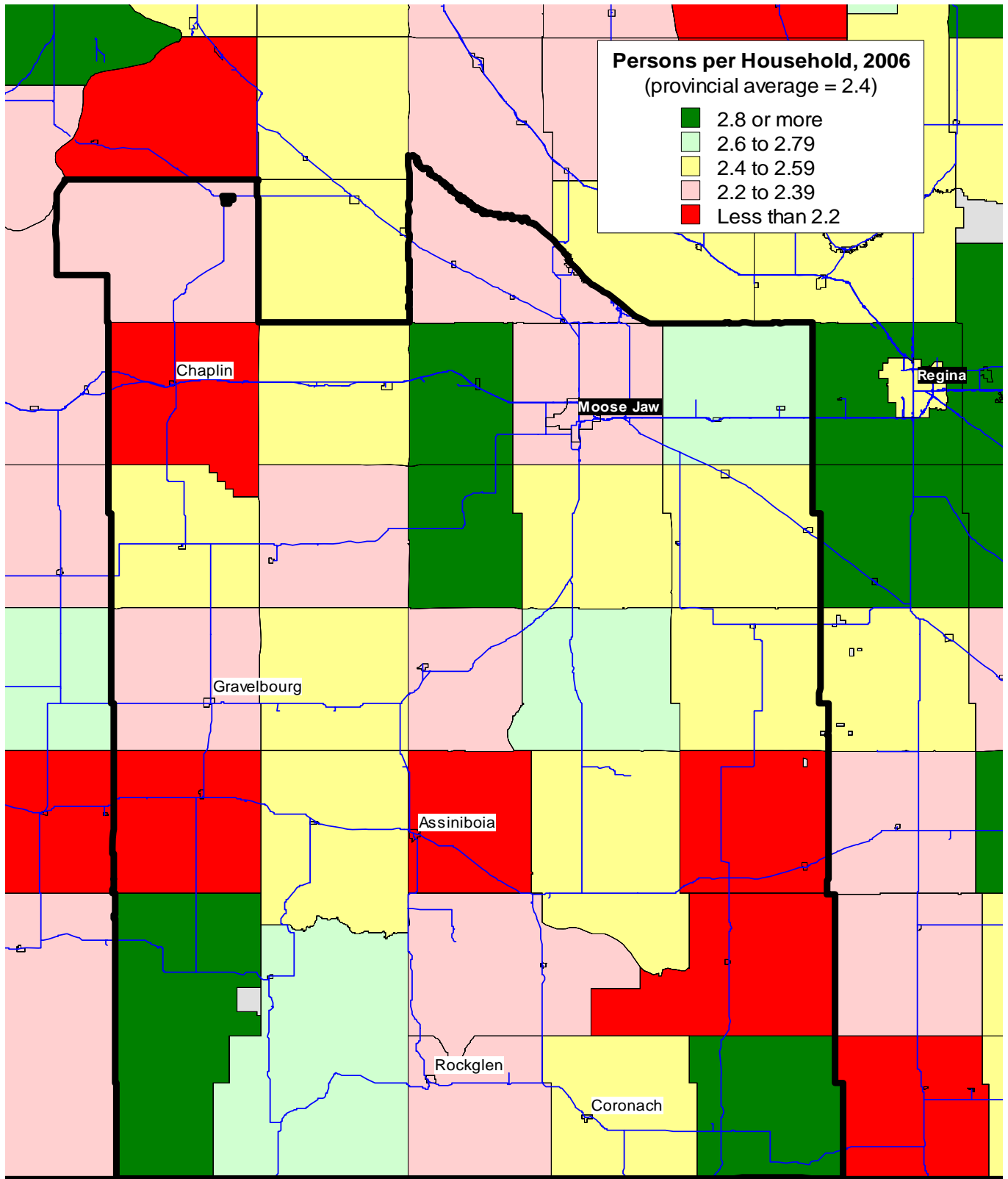
Change in Housing Condition, 1996 to 2006



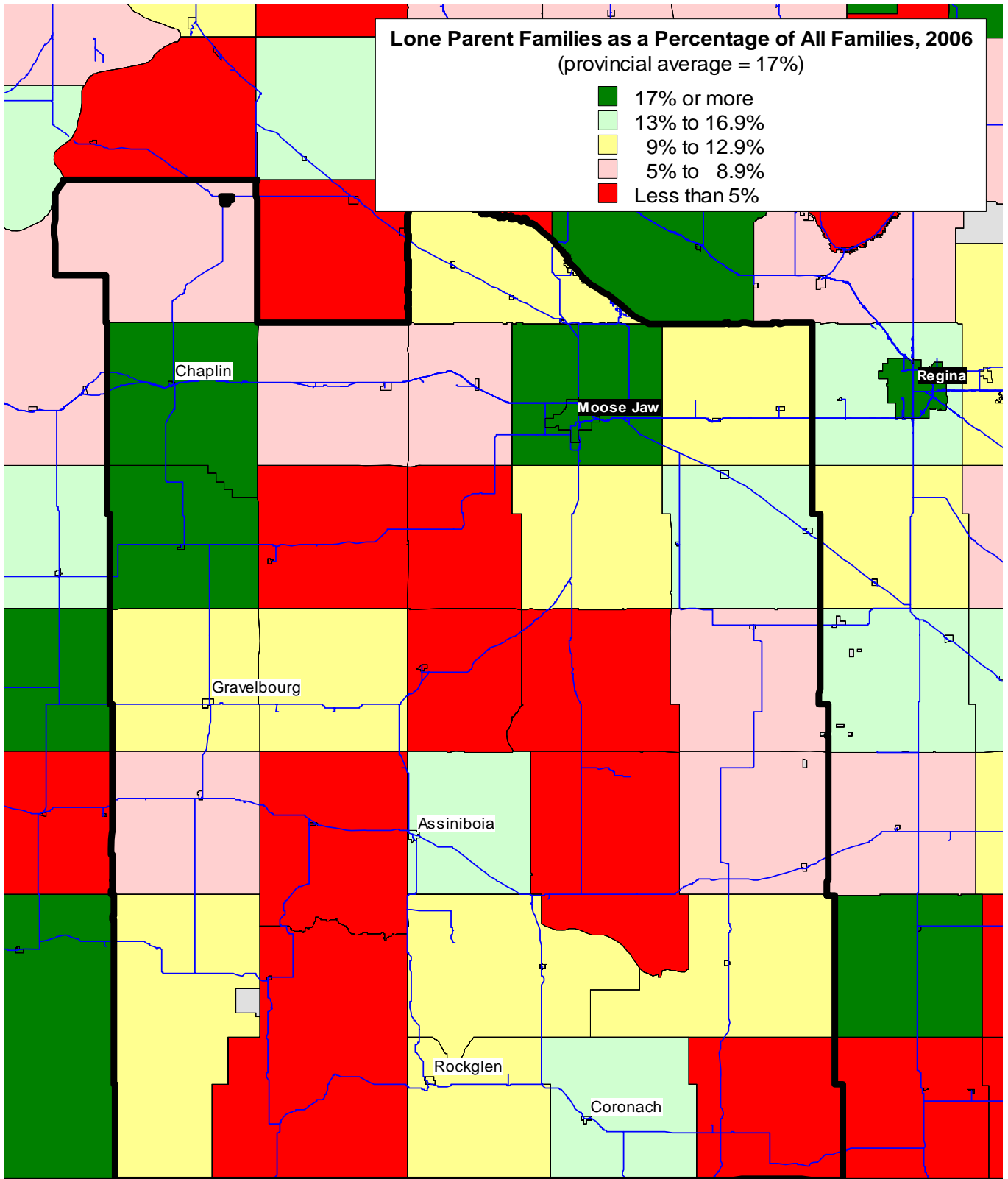
Housing Condition in 2006



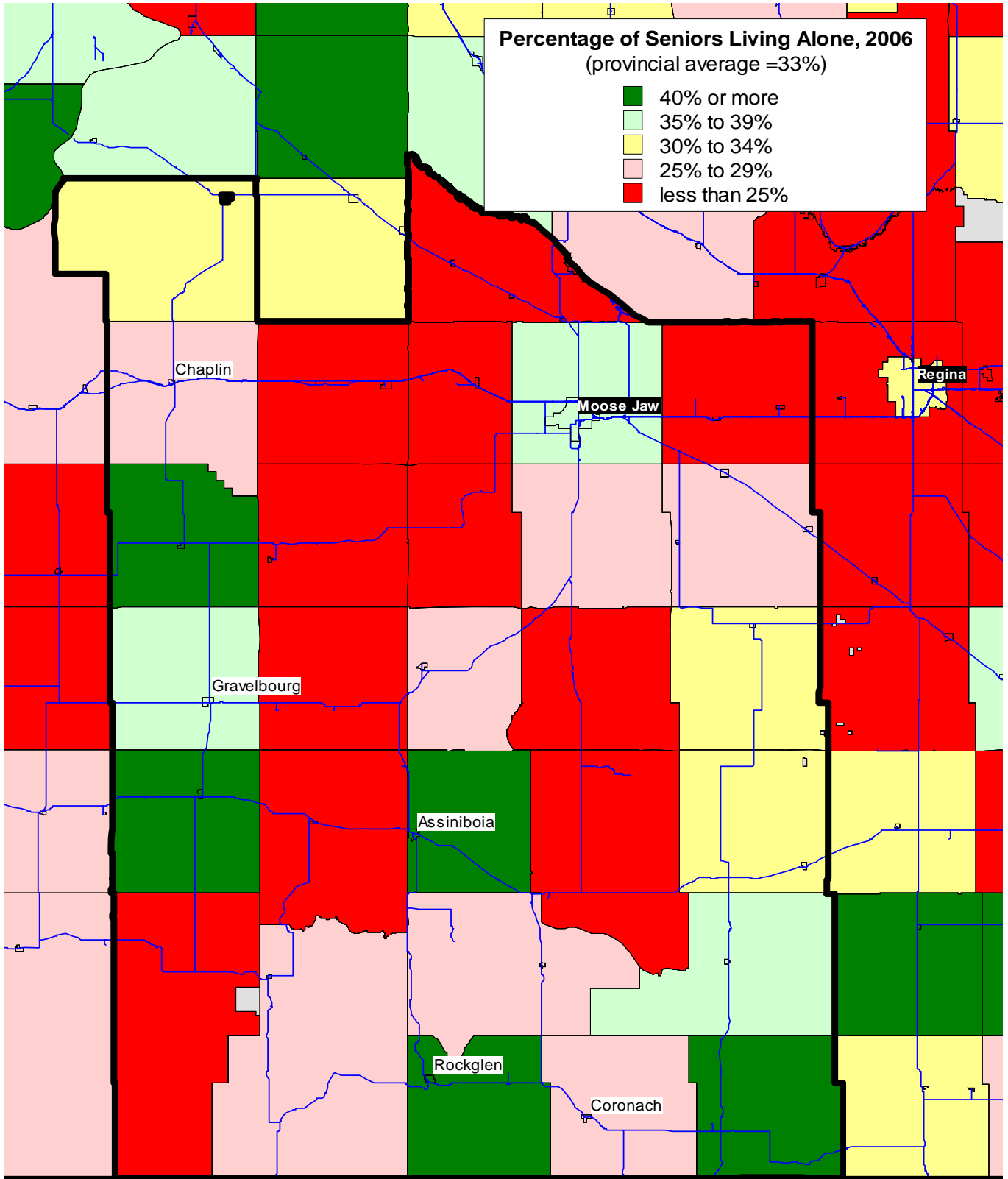
Average Number of Persons per Household, 2006, by RM



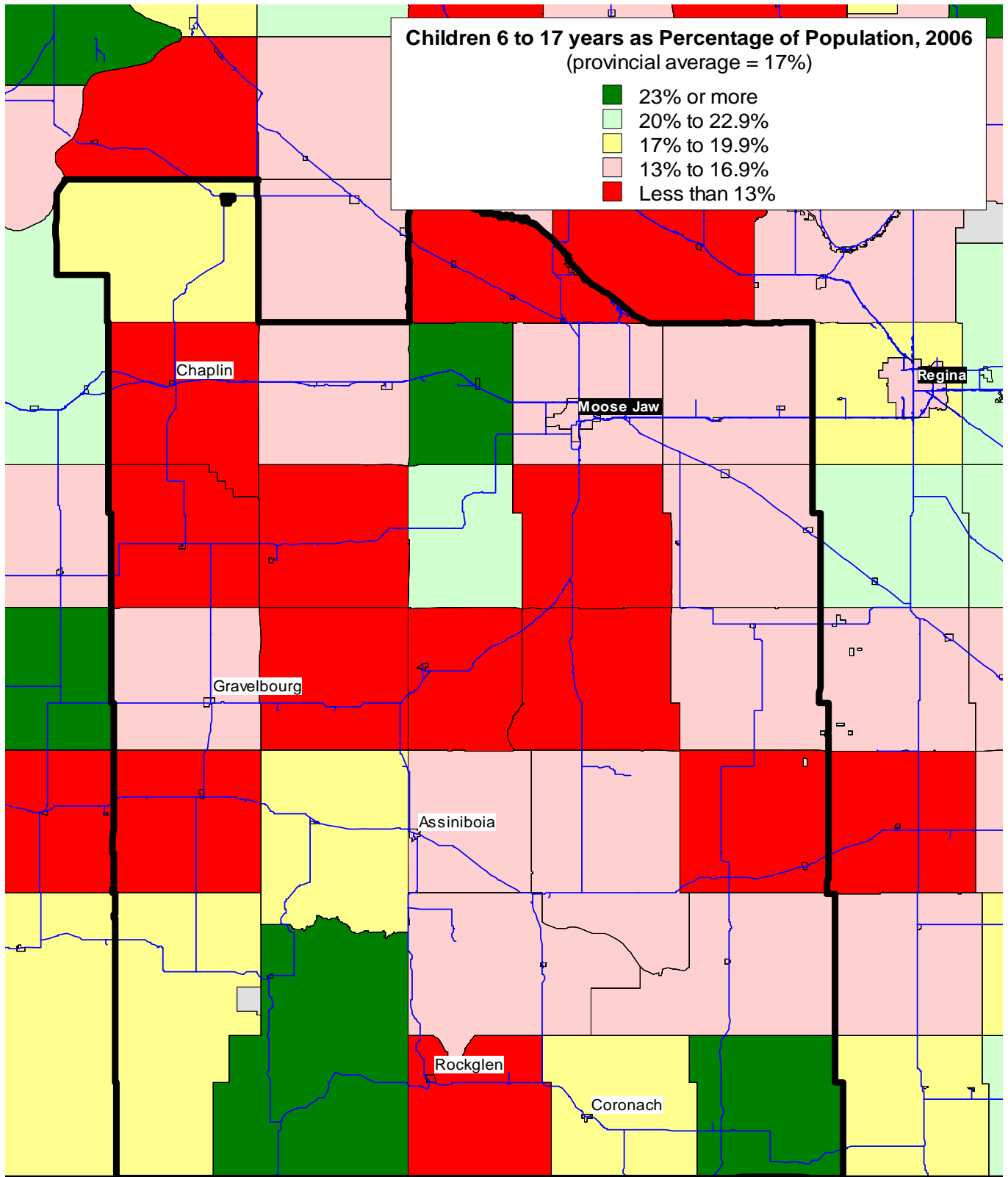
Lone Parent Families in 2006, by RM



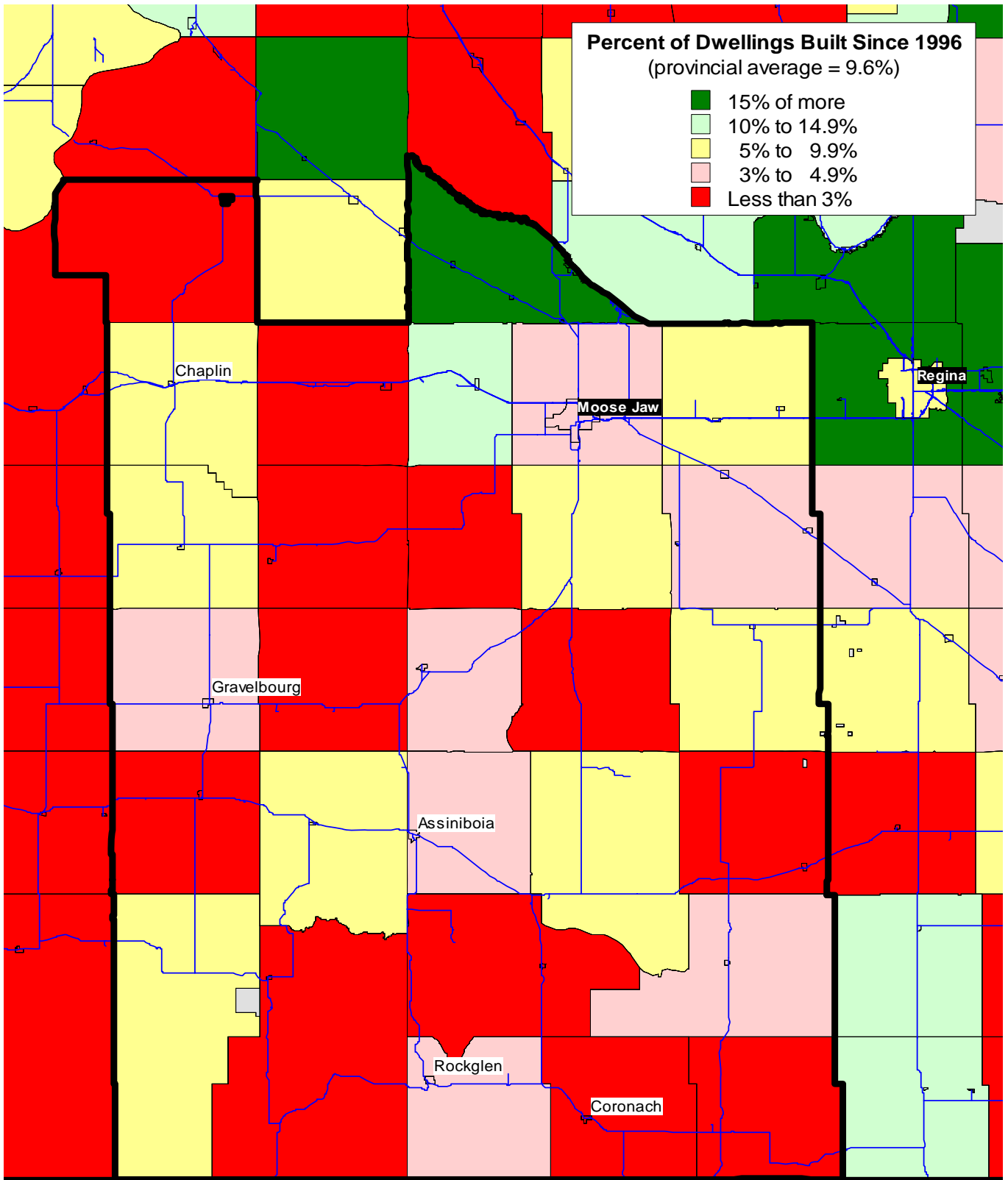
Seniors Living Alone in 2006, by RM
