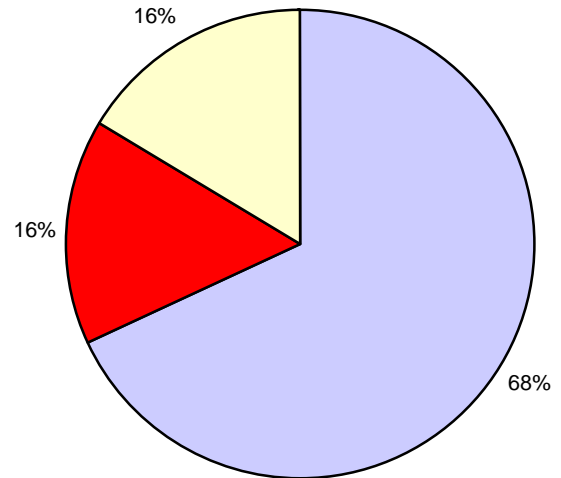

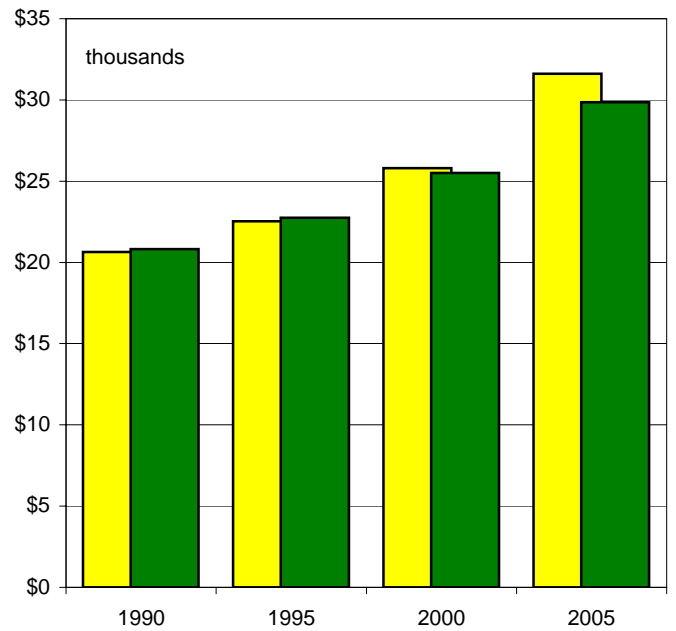
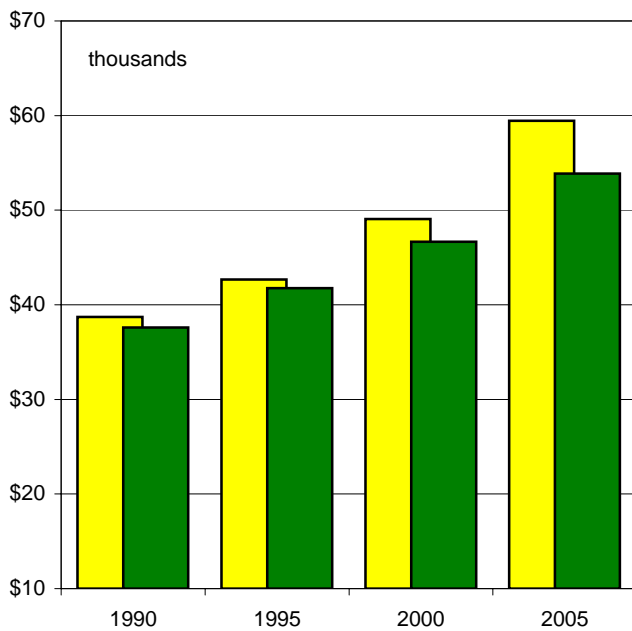

Average Household Income

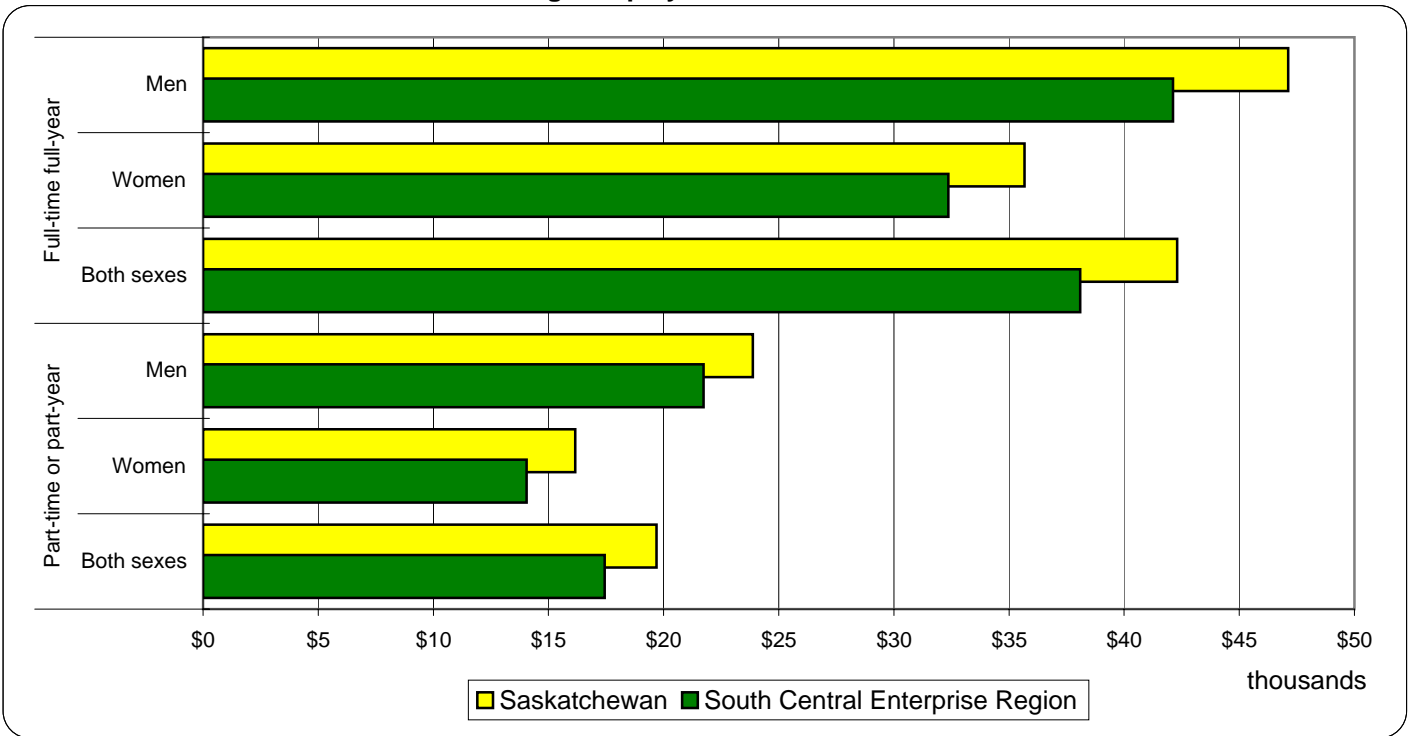

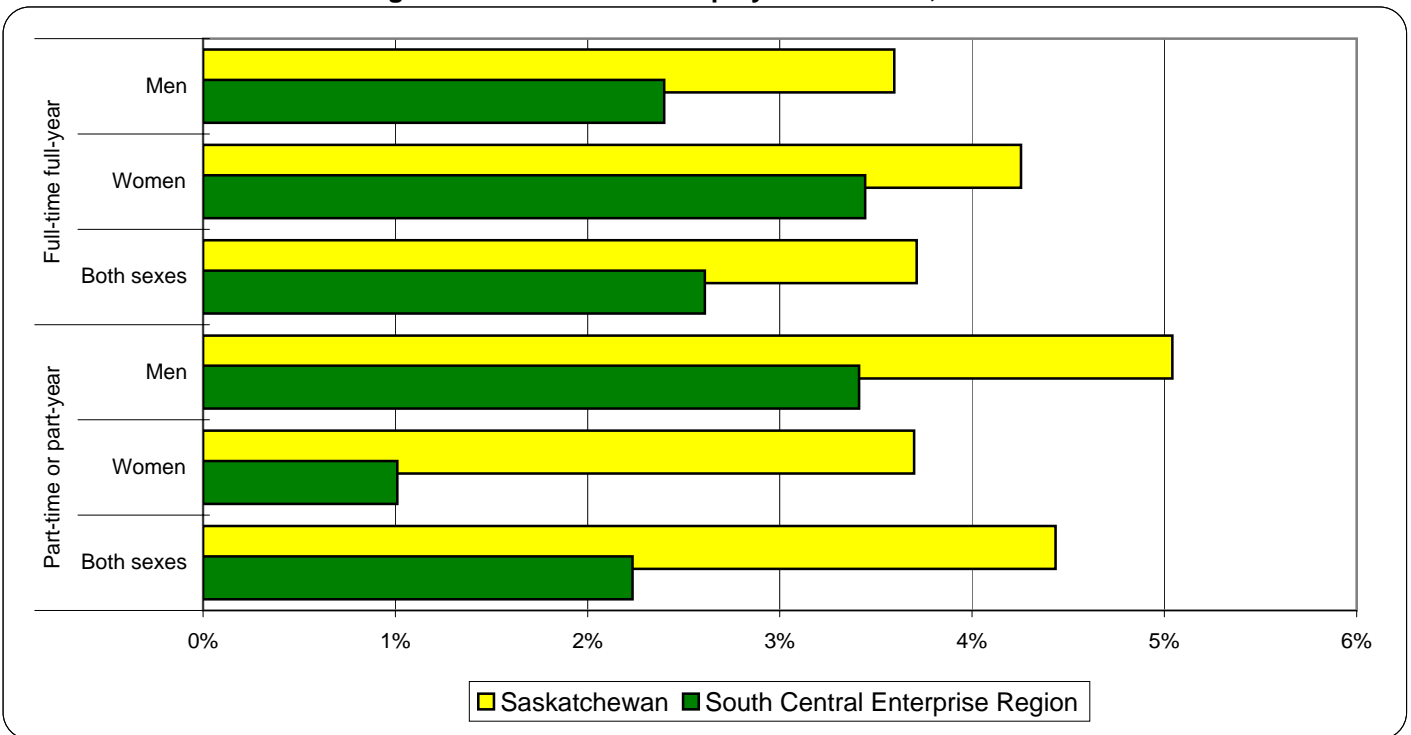

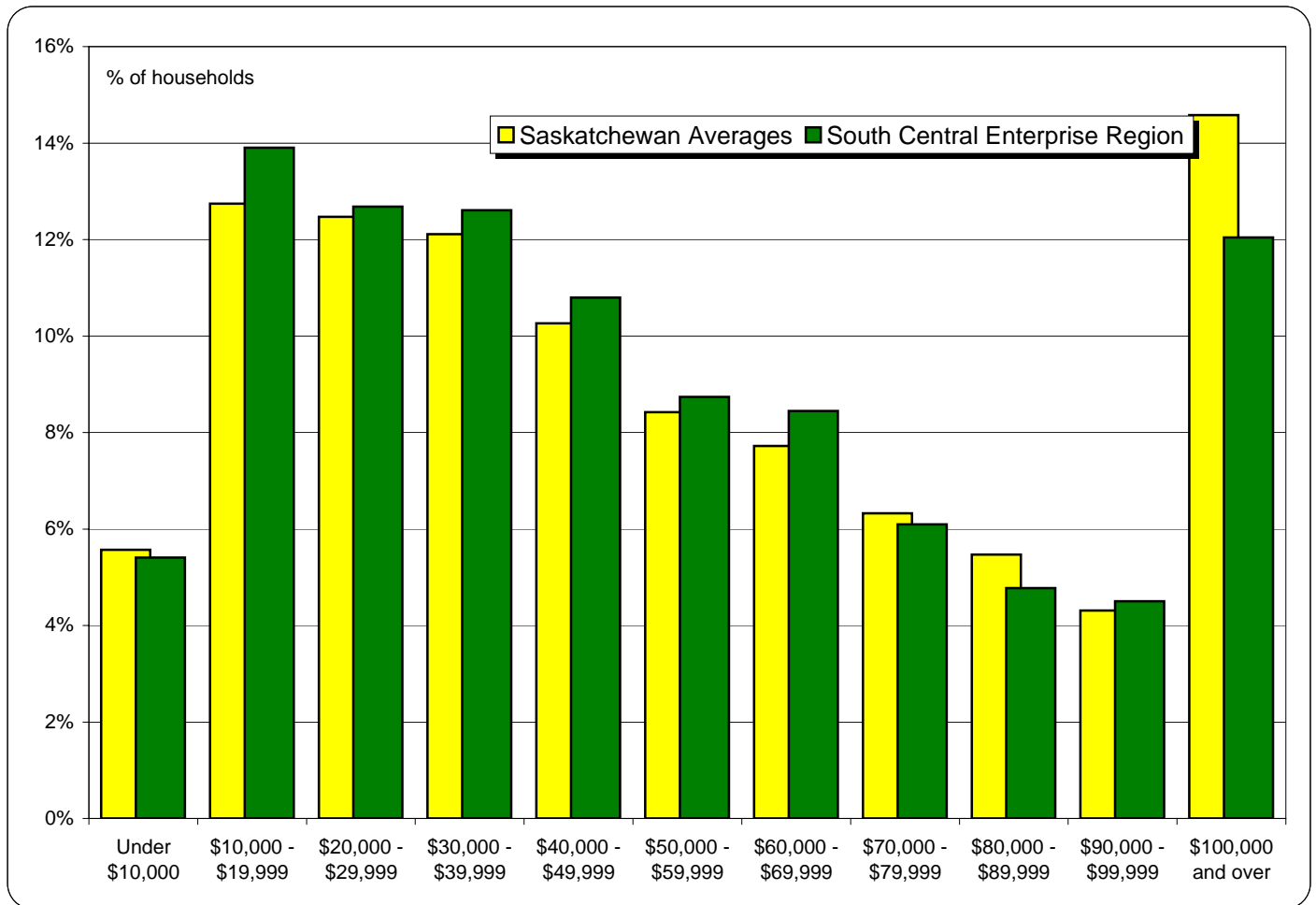
Average Employment Income in 2005



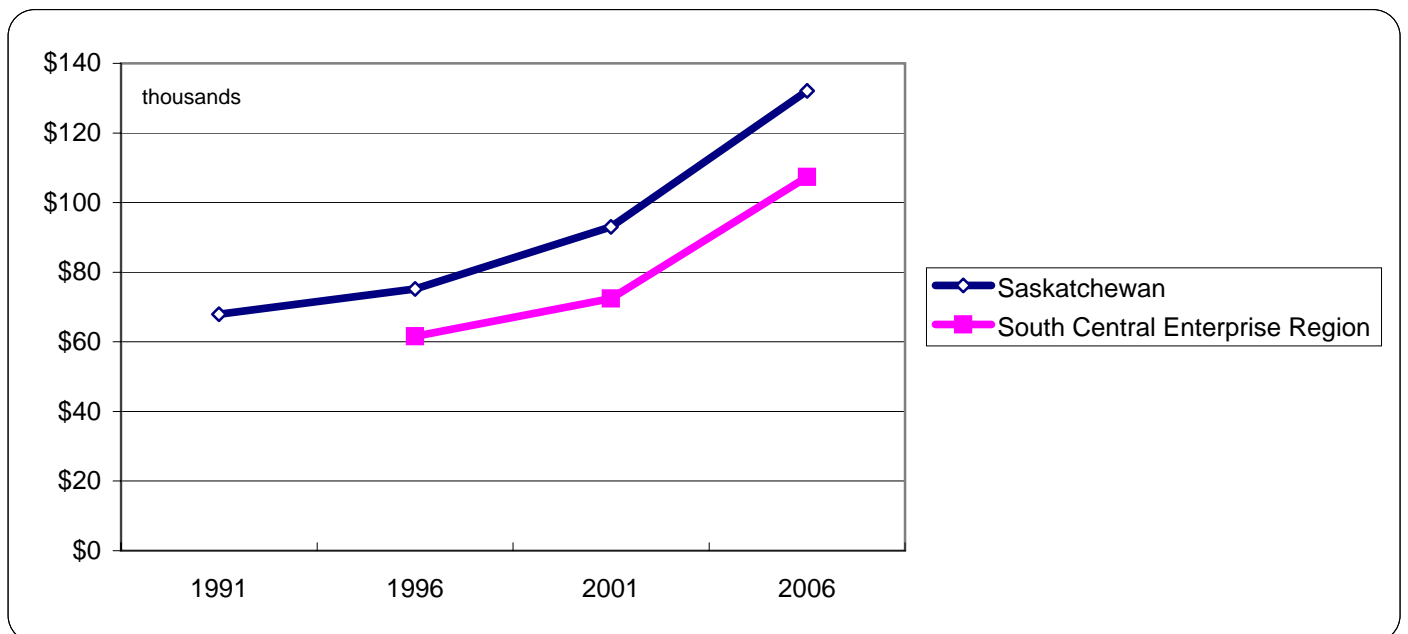
Average Annual Increase in Employment Income, 2000 to 2005



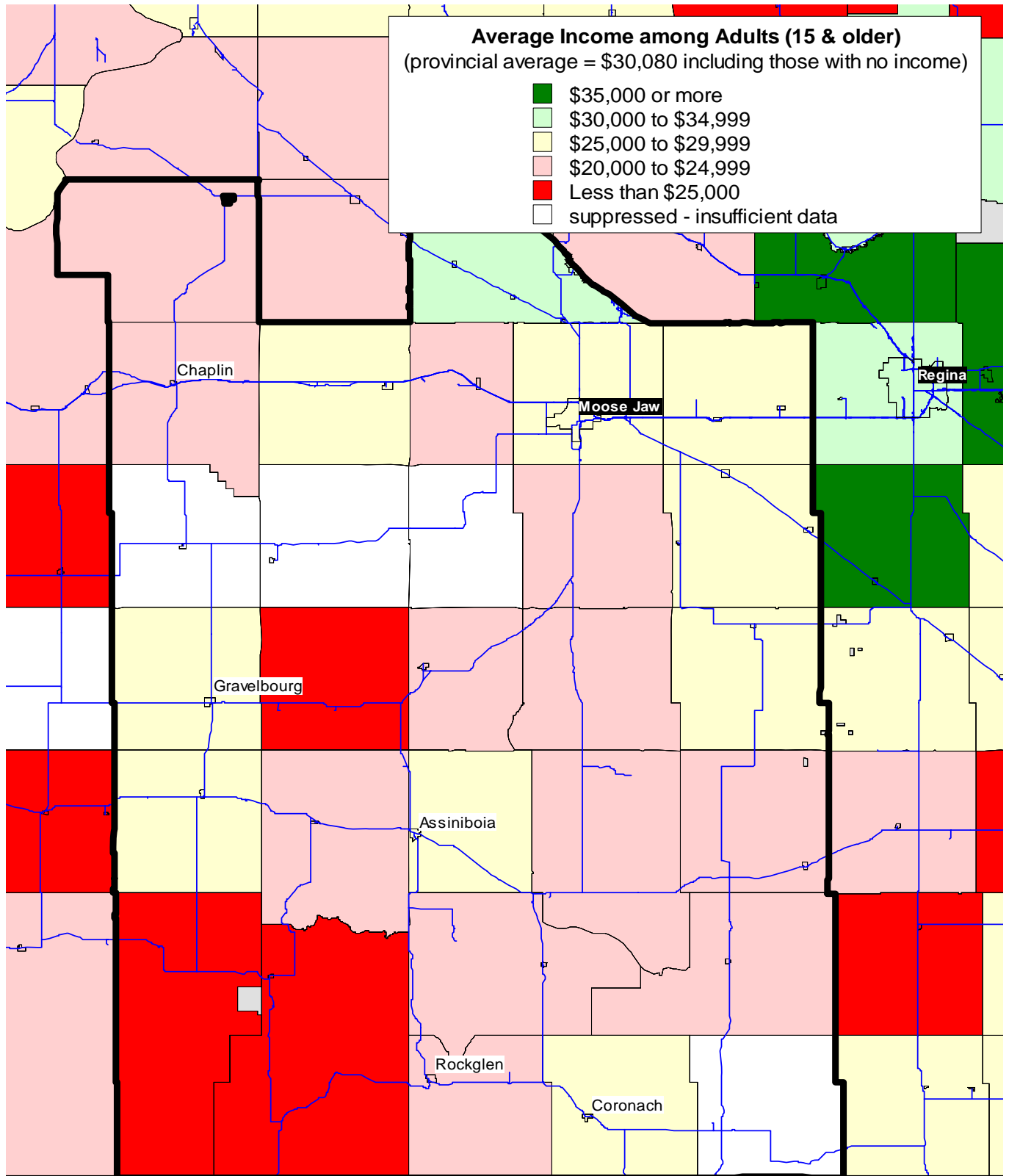
Distribution of Household Incomes in 2005



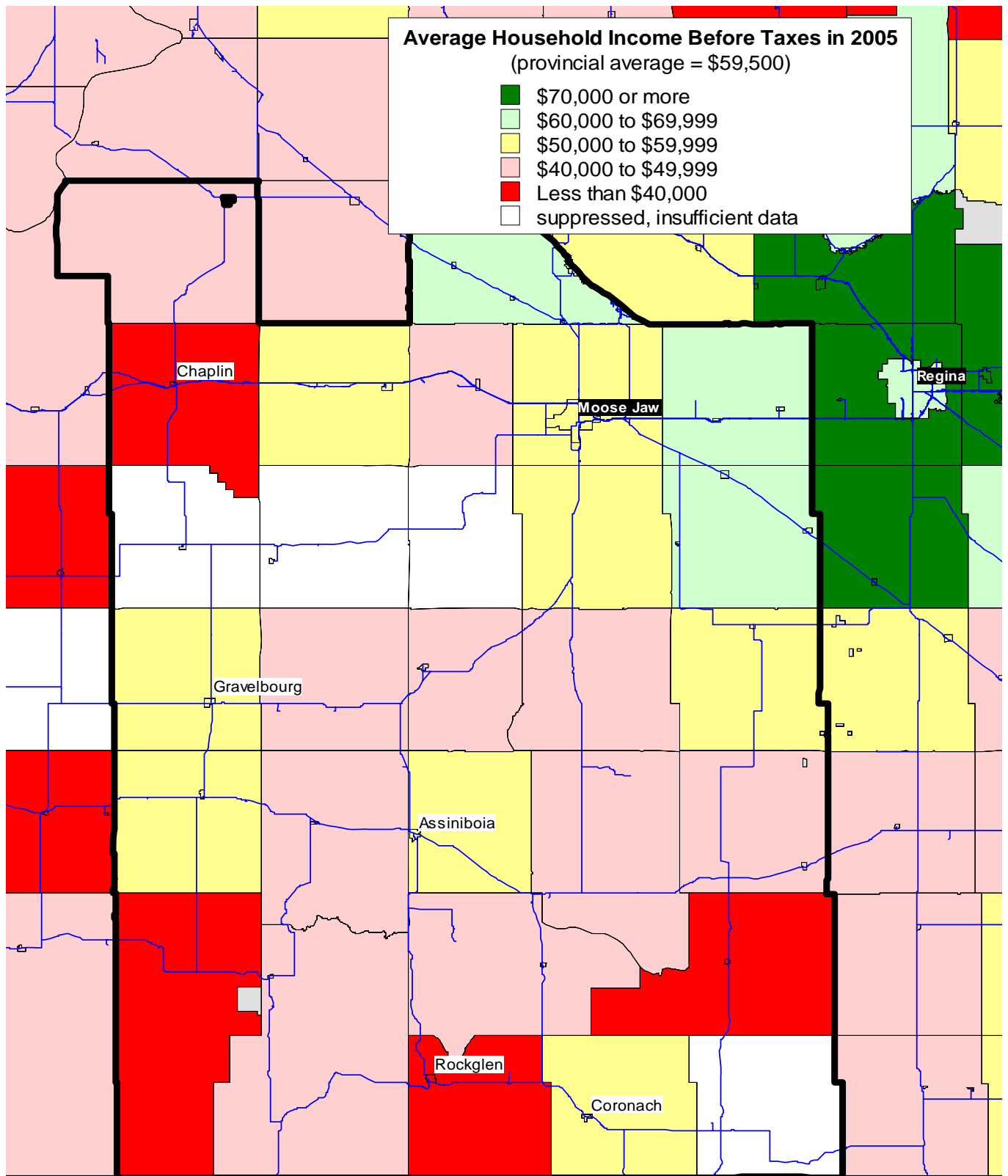
Estimated Market Value of Owner-Occupied Non-Reserve Non-Farm Dwellings



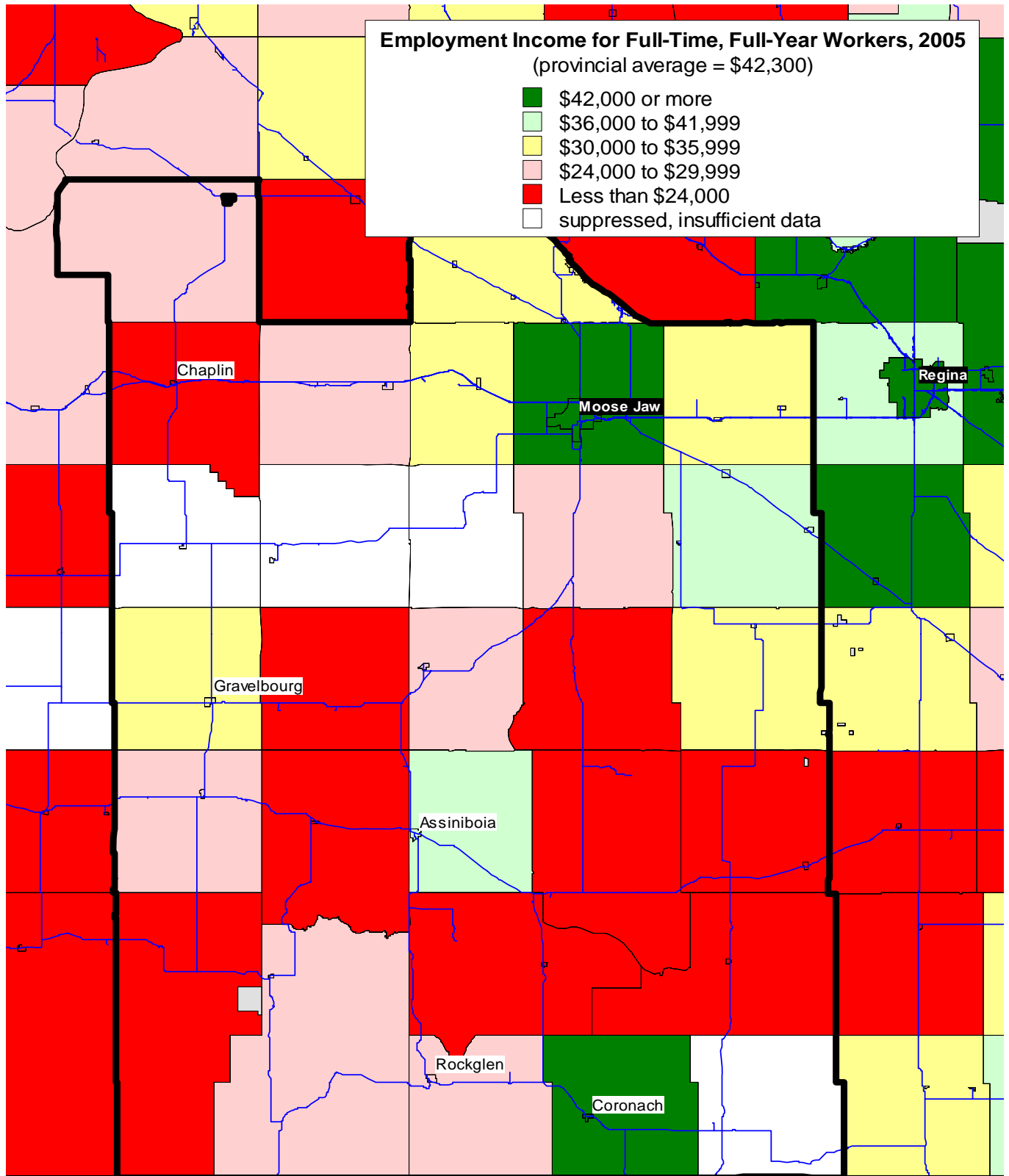
Average Individual Income in 2005, by RM



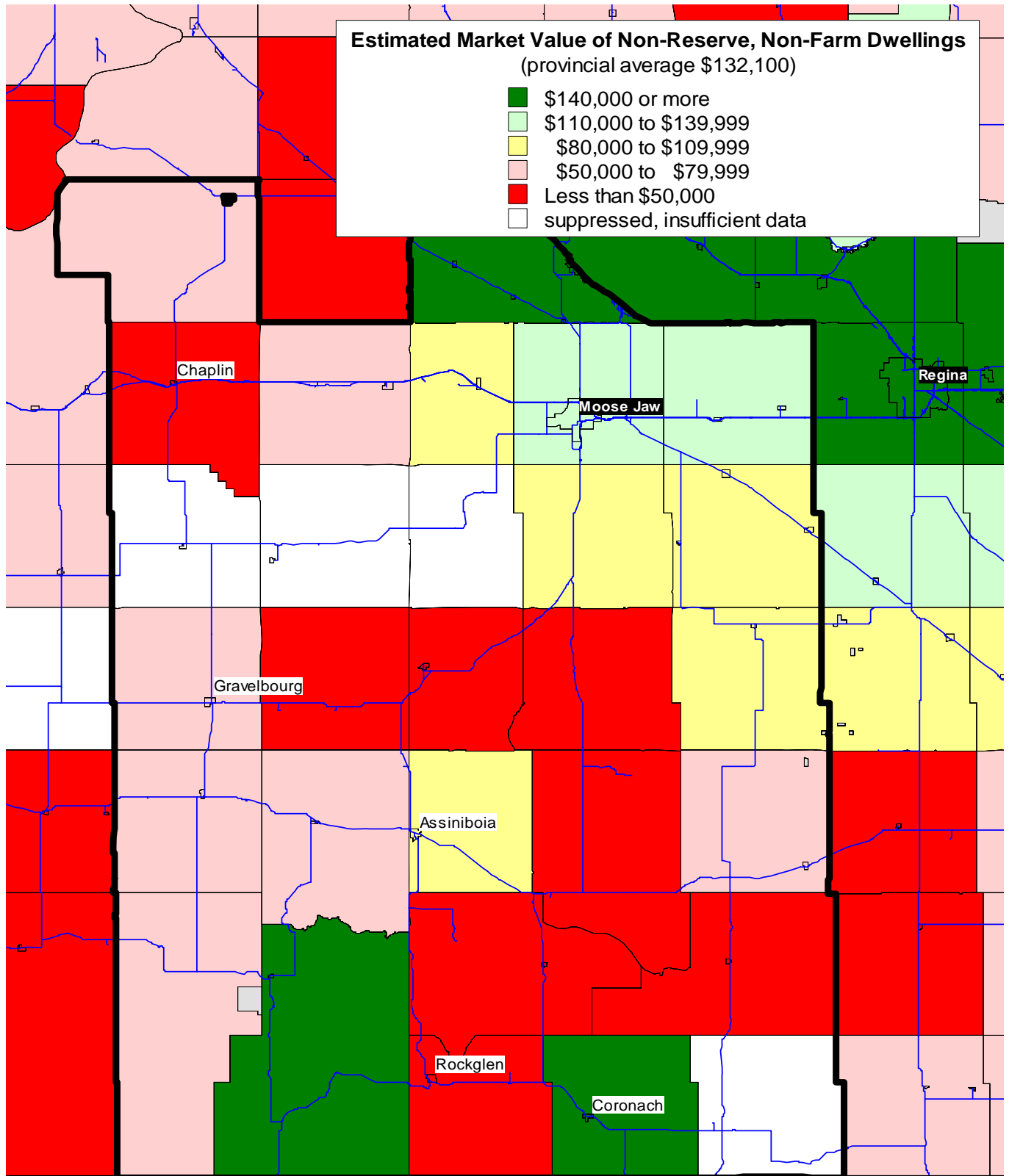
Average Household Income in 2005, by RM



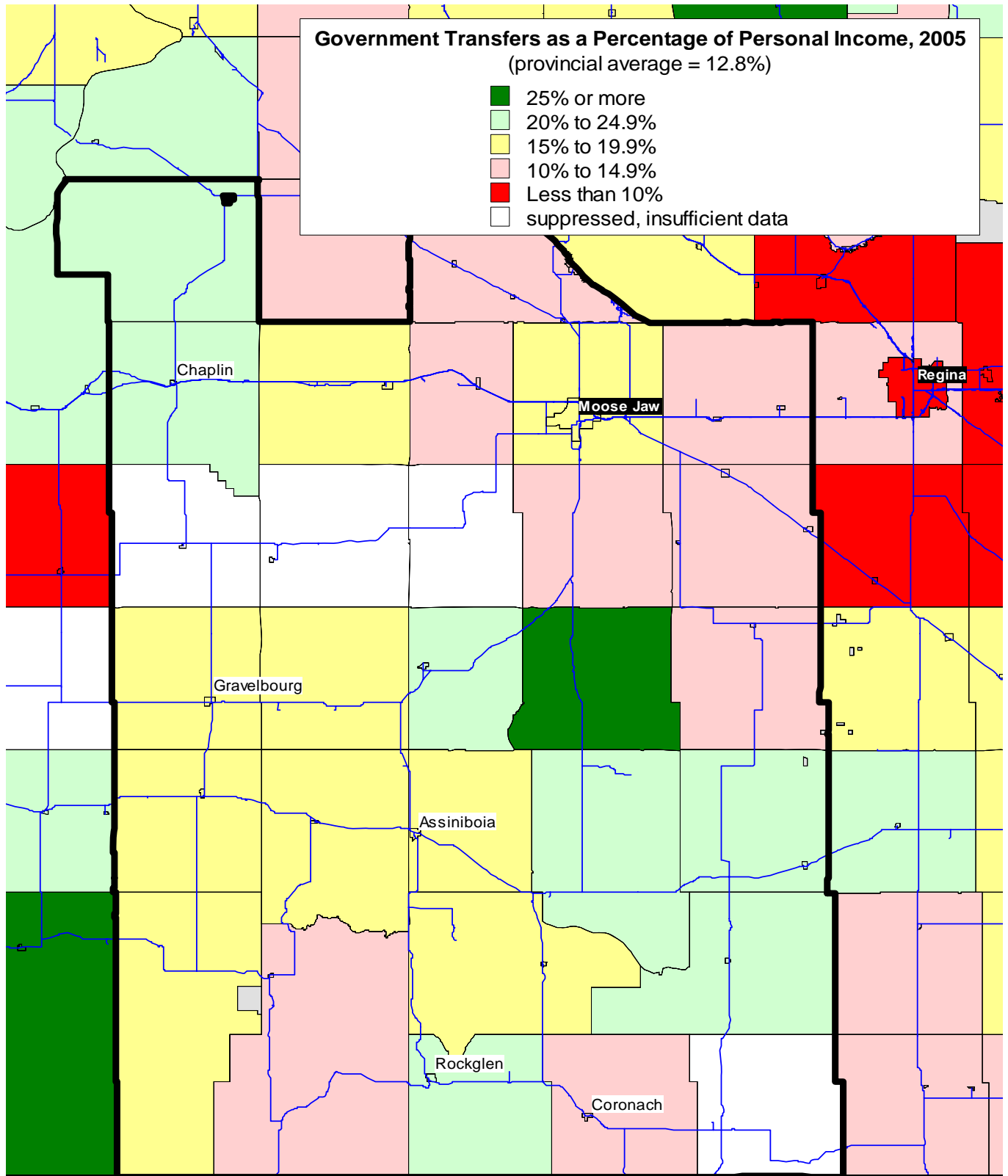
Average Employment Income, Full-Time, Full-Year Workers, by RM, 2005
